PMC Diploma Week Course

A whole week working with PMC at intermediate and advanced level. Go home with at least a dozen great silver items.

Three day Intermediate skills in PMC (Grade 2) covers stone and glass setting, bead making, carving, making two rings, weaving PMC paper for earrings, making and soldering silver jump rings and more.

Two day Advanced PMC techniques (Grade 3) includes box making, pendants with keum boo, earrings with gold slip and gold clay, patina, making your own textures, setting non-fired stones, attaching findings, making sterling silver clasps and more.

These grades count towards your PMC Diploma. Ideal for those coming from a distance.
